## Materials Characterization Facility X-ray Diffraction Lab rules

Before reading these rules read the general ones

- It is your responsibility to check the operating conditions of the X-ray generator and diffractometer before starting your session.
- Read all signs posted on the instrument and logbook, as they may include instructions and/or notices about changes in the instrument.
- Report any malfunction immediately.
- Take all of your samples with you at the end of your session. Specimens left in the XRD Lab may be discarded at any time.
- Internet connection through the PANalytical PC is **strictly limited to e-mail checking** (it is forbidden to downloading and opening the attachment files).
- Remember to sign out from the "database" computer (the one used for the phase identification) at the end of your session.
- In the use of the PANalytical Empyrean diffractometer follow these rules:
  - before starting your XRD session, check the Tension and Current values: 30 kV and 10 mA
  - the minimum starting angle allowed 2θ = 5°
  - the maximum value allowed for the "Time per step (s)" 500 s
  - whenever any error message appears, stop your session and contact the XRD Lab staff
  - fill always the logbooks with a legible writing.

If users are more than 15 mins late for a booking, they must contact the laboratory manager, or the booking will be cancelled. Repeated lateness for bookings may result in the user losing access privileges to the laboratory.
